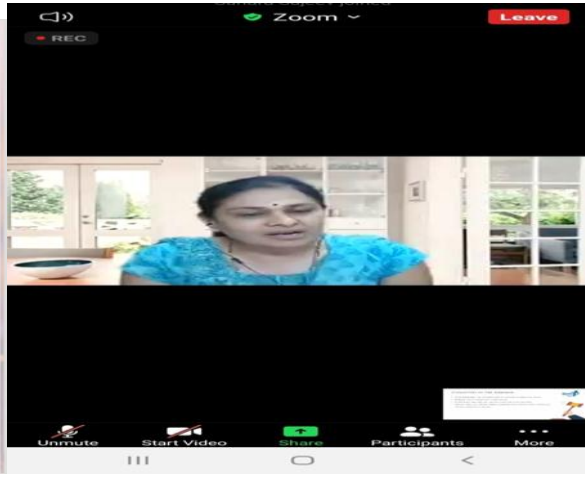








Awareness Webinar on Child Abuse and Violence against Children




Blood Donation Camp II - Blood Donation Day - 01 October, 2021

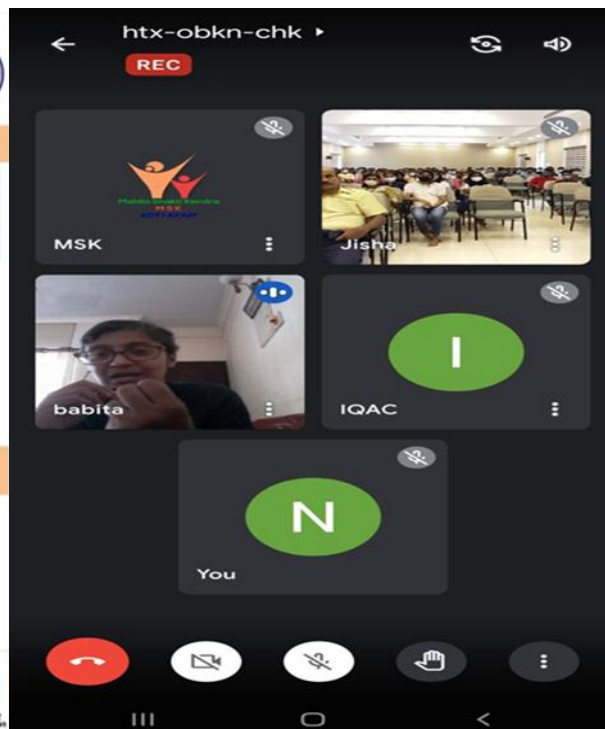
